Lufthansa Systems and Emirates Airline extend their longstanding Lido Flight 4D partnership

The Dubai-based carrier signs contract extension and switches from being self-hosted to being Lufthansa Systems cloud-hosted

Raunheim, 7 June 2022 – Lufthansa Systems announced that Emirates Airline has renewed its partnership with Lufthansa Systems by entering into a new contract for its Lido Flight 4D flight planning solution for seven years. This includes a migration of the existing Lido Flight Planning Solution from their Emirates-hosted environment to the Lufthansa Systems-hosted Azure Cloud environment.
