Lido mPilot A350 Integration.

Heightened situational awareness

Lido mPilot brings seamless integration between the iPad Electronic Flight Bag (EFB) and the Airbus A350 avionics environment. Pilots benefit from improved visibility, intuitive interaction, and real-time aircraft data—directly on the A350 display units.

Own ship depiction via avionics interface

Lido mPilot supports the Airbus A350 avionics interface, enabling depiction of the own ship symbol based on real-time aircraft position data. This ensures precise situational awareness during all phases of flight, from taxi to enroute operations.

Extended visual access in the cockpit

With Lido mPilot, the iPad can be mirrored or extended directly onto the Airbus A350 display units. This capability, previously available for Windows EFBs, now extends fully to iPad users—allowing pilots to access critical navigation information without diverting their attention to side-mounted devices.

KCCU & folding table keyboard integration

Lido mPilot supports connection to external peripherals when used with a mirroring screen, including:

- Keyboard and mouse
- Trackball and scroll wheel
- Folding table keyboard with touchpad

This enables pilots to interact with Lido mPilot directly from the cockpit interface.

Supported gestures & controls

Mouse support

- Zoom in and out on Lido AMM, Enroute, and Terminal maps using the scroll wheel
- Click and drag to pan maps
- Scroll vertically and horizontally in General, SAI, and CCI documents
- Scroll within the Lido AMM frequency box
- Right-click on airports in the flight folder to open context menus and delete entries

Document interaction

- Select text in General, SAI, and CCI documents
- Use magnifier sliders to zoom in and out (available when connected to a mirroring screen)

Keyboard support

- Enter and modify text
- Use arrow keys to switch between terminal charts

Touchpad support

- Perform standard touch and pinch gestures, equivalent to direct touchscreen interaction
